

Technique: Continuous Wrap-around Loop (CWL)
Pattern: Five 10-bead double Continuous Wrap-around Loops.

1. Leave a 5-inch (12.7 cm) tail and make a 10-bead loop.
2. Move the working wire to the left. (*Photo 1*)
3. Feed enough beads onto the working wire and wrap it around the initial loop. Reposition so that the tail-wire is facing upwards so that it's easier to wrap. (*Photo 2*)
4. Take the bare wire and wrap it behind the tail-wire then bring it back to the front. (*Photo 3*) You now have one **10-bead double wrap-around loop**.
5. Make sure the working-wire is on the right. Leave approx. 1/4 inch (5 mm) of bare wire so there will be room to wrap. Make another 10-bead loop. (*Photo 4*)
6. Move the working-wire to the left and feed more beads from the spool. (*Photo 5*) Make another wrap-around loop.
7. Follow Steps 2 to 6 until you have all five petals. You now have five **10-bead double continuous wrap-around loops (CWL)**. (*Photo 6*)
8. Cut 5 inches (12.7 cm) of wire from the spool. Twist both wires together at the base.

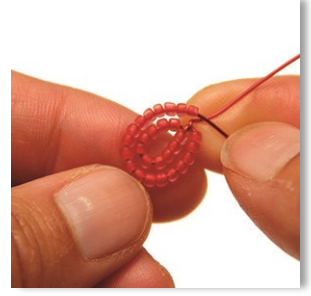

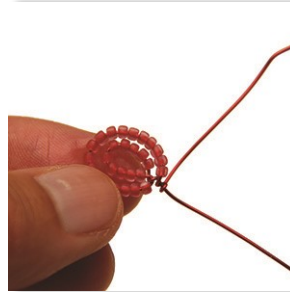

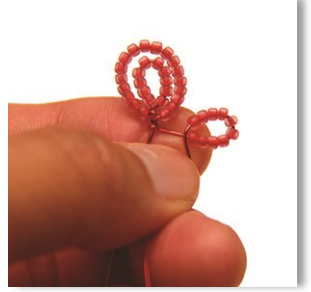

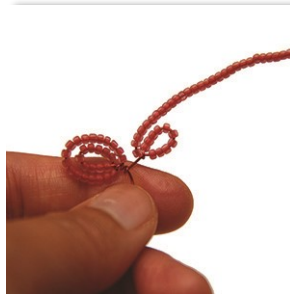
