

**PETALS** - petal color beads

**Technique:** Triple Split Basic

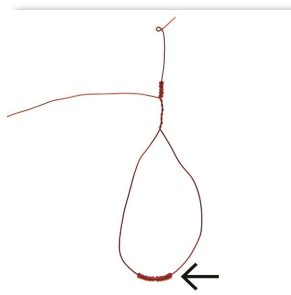
**Pattern:** 5-bead triple split basic, RT PB, 9 rows

**1. Triple Split Basic.** Make a basic frame with 5 beads on the basic wire and 10 beads in the basic loop. (*Photo 1*) Follow the pattern to create 9 rows.

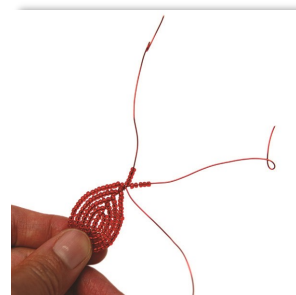
**2** Undo any twists on the twisted wire and move 5 beads to each side of the loop. Cut the top of the loop and knot the end of each wire. (*Photo 2*)

**3.** Twist the working-wire and one of the cut-wires up 1/2 inch (1.2 cm) to form a new twisted wire. (*Photo 3*) Follow the pattern to make the second petal.

**4.** Twist the working-wire and the second cut-wire up 1/2 inch (1.2 cm) and make the last petal. The working-wire is now between the second and last petal. Cut 3 inches (7.6 cm) of wire off the spool. The working-wire is now the tail-wire. (*Photo 4*)
