



FRENCH BEADED DAISY – BEGINNER

MATERIALS (FOR 1 FLOWER):

- <1 gram 11/0 yellow seed beads
- 2 grams 11/0 white seed beads
- 5 grams 11/0 green seed beads
- Floral tape (7 inches)

TOOLS:

- Wire cutters
- Bead spinner (optional, but recommended)
- Scissors

TECHNIQUES:

- Continuous Loops

PREPARE: String 2.25 inches (5.7 cm) of yellow seed beads onto a 10-inch (25.4 cm) length of silver or gold wire.

PETALS

Pattern: Three $\frac{3}{4}$ inch (1.9 cm) continuous loops (CL)

1. Leave a 3-inch (12.7 cm) tail. (*Photo 1*)
2. Measure $\frac{3}{4}$ inch (1.9 cm) of beads and move them to the 3-inch mark. (*Photo 2*)
3. Cross the wires below the beads (*Photo 3*) and twist twice to form a loop.
4. Follow Steps 2 to 4 and until you have three loops total.
5. Twist the two ending tail-wires together.

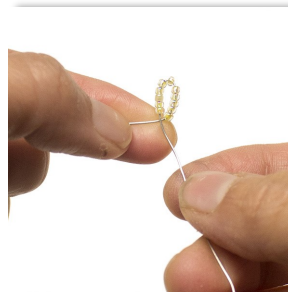

PREPARE: String 4-inches (10.7 cm) of green beads onto a 12-inch (30.4 cm) length of green wire.

CALYX

Pattern: Five $\frac{3}{4}$ inch (1.9 cm) continuous loops (CL)

1. Leave a 3-inch (12.7 cm) tail and make follow the above pattern. (*Photo 5*)
2. Twist the two ending tail wires together.

PREPARE: String 12 inches (30.4 cm) of white beads onto a 24-inch (60.9 cm) length of silver or white wire.

PETALS

Pattern: Eight 1.5 inch (3.8 cm) CL

1. Leave a 3-inch (12.7 cm) tail and make follow the above pattern.
2. Twist the two ending tail wires together. (*Photo 5*)

PREPARE: String 12-inches (30.4 cm) of green beads onto a 20-inch (50.8 cm) length of green wire.

LEAVES

Pattern: Two 6-inch (15.2 cm) CL

1. Leave a 3-inch (12.7 cm) tail and make follow the above pattern. (*Photo 6*)

2. Twist each loop several times like *Photo 7*. See finished **Leaves** in *Photo 8*.

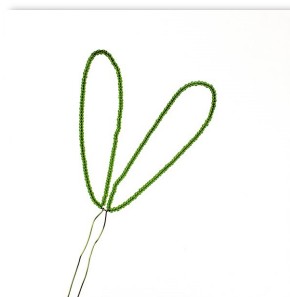

ASSEMBLY

1. Insert the **Center** in the **Petals** then insert into the **Sepals**.

2. Twist the wires together to form a stem wire. **Tip:** Place the base of the flower between the “scissor” of your index and middle finger and twist with other hand.

3. Stretch out the end of the floral tape gently. (*Photo 11*)

4. Wrap the floral tape around the stem wire down about 2 inches (15.2 cm). (*Photo 12*)

5. Place the Leaves next to the stem and then wrap in with floral tape down about 2 inches (5 cm). (*Photo 13*)

6. Trim the stem wire to the desired length and finish wrapping with floral tape. Cut the excess floral tape and wrap it around the end of the stem.

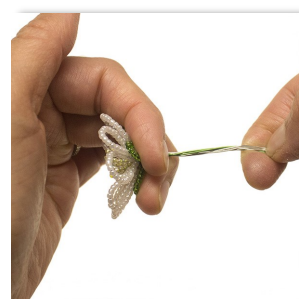

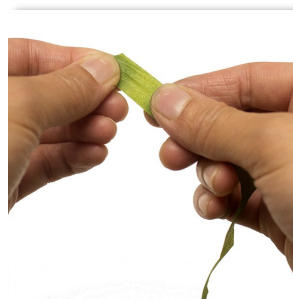

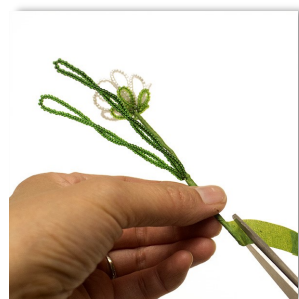
